"TANABATA"

"Tanabata" is an event related to the stars. It is based on the legend that only once a year, Hikoboshi (Cow herder) and Orihime (Weaving Princess), two lovers, would be allowed to meet each other at the shores of the heavenly river. The moment would take place on the night of July 7th in the lunisolar calendar.

Hikoboshi and Orihime were husband and wife. They were so deeply in love with each other that they ended up neglecting their duties. As punishment, they were separated and only allowed to meet one another once a year.

If it rains on Tanabata night, the only chance when Hikoboshi and Orihime can meet in a year, the heavenly river will be flooded with rainwater. Both lover will become unable to meet each other.


NESTING TOOL

Improve your material utilization!

Nesting tool has relief from clamp holders.

Therefore, operator minimized clamp holding material as little as possible.

You can improve material utilization so much.



Remarks

- 1. Process of regrinding tool is same as standard tools. In case regrinding amount is more than 1 mm, it is necessary to grind die relief area.
